During 2022 Cumbria Rural Choirs, which was originally formed in 1950, was relaunched as Cumbria Singers. Information about Cumbria Rural Choirs, including a list of the concerts that were performed between 1950-2022, can be found at **www.cumbria-rural-choirs.org**

Cumbria Singers draws its membership from across Cumbria and beyond. With over 100 singers, it is the largest amateur choir in north Cumbria.

In 2023 it successfully performed Haydn's Creation in Carlisle Cathedral. This was followed in 2024 by a performance of 'The Music Makers' by Elgar and Faure's 'Requiem' & 'Cantique de Jean Racine'

In the words of the independent reviewer:

Elgar's The Music Makers, challenging to perform and relatively unfamiliar compared to his best-known works, was a courageous opening choice for the annual concert given by this choir of 100 singers. They definitely rose to the occasion.... and responded with energy, vibrancy and lyricism as required. I imagine, for the chorus members at least, the second half of the programme brought a feeling of 'now we are on familiar ground' with Fauré's much-loved setting of the Requiem. Nevertheless, this work's mainly restrained and contemplative mood brings its own challenges in terms of the breath control needed in held notes and extended melodic lines. This was ably achieved by the choir including the sections for sopranos or tenors alone.... We were finally offered one more treat, almost an encore, in Fauré's setting of the prayer known as the Cantique de Jean Racine. This brief gem, by the 19 year old composer, brought a memorable concert to a fitting close.

Performing: Five Mystical Songs' by Vaughan Williams: ; Bob Chilcott's 'Requiem' and 'Gloria' by John Rutter. The Conductor will be Matthew Owens who is also Cumbria Singers' Music Director for 2024-25 season. The choir will be accompanied by professional musicians and soloists.
